WHAT ARE INVASIVE SPECIES?

Invasive species are non-native plants, animals, and diseases that cause harm to the environment, human health and the economy.

WHY ARE INVASIVE SPECIES A PROBLEM?

Since they do not have any natural predators, invasive species can quickly take over an area - reproducing quickly and out-competing native species, disrupting food webs and ecosystems.

Some invaders can also threaten human health, like the mosquitocarried Zika and West Nile viruses.

In 2019, Ontario spent \$50.8 million on invasive species management.

ARE ALL SPECIES FROM DIFFERENT COUNTRIES INVASIVE?

No - some non-native species are beneficial, such as honeybees, while others do not cause any real harm to the native ecosystem.
